The Luxembourg Income Study (LIS) asbl, a non-profit microdata archive and research center located in Luxembourg, seeks applications for a Microdata Expert.

LIS provides access to harmonized microdata from over 30 countries, enabling cross-national comparative research on diverse socio-economic outcomes.

The position involves harmonizing and documenting microdata in the areas of income, employment, demographics, and wealth; the job also entails contributing to the conceptual framework underlying the harmonization process. Opportunities for carrying out research projects using the LIS data are available if desired.

The successful candidate will have an MA or PhD in sociology, economics, demography, statistics or another social science. Extensive experience with microdata using Stata, SAS, or SPSS is required, as is attention to detail. Experience in social science or policy research is desirable. The working language of the LIS office is English.
